The Chorale will join with other select choruses in the spectacular six-day festival culminating in a performance of Mozart's *Mass in C "Coronation"*, K.317, with accompaniment by full orchestra and European soloists under the direction of Herr Czifra, and selected music to be directed by Dr. Ehly, one of America's foremost conductors and clinicians. The finale concerts will take place in the Dom in Salzburg and the beautiful Votivkirche in Vienna.
